

WHALES OF THE BAJA

La Paz, Baja California Sur, Mexico – Land Based

AS THE NORTHERN PACIFIC WATER TEMPERATURES TURN ICY COLD, MANY NORTHEASTERN PACIFIC WHALES MIGRATE SOUTH TO THE WARMER WATERS OF THE BAJA.

GRAY WHALES:

- * Winter on the Pacific side of the Baja Peninsula in the shallow waters of three distinct lagoons Main Activities:
- * 12 14 hours whale watching over 3 days
- * Hike over desert terrain and coastal sand dunes
- * Enjoy spectacular birdwatching in mangroves and along the coastline

BLUE WHALES:

- * Arrive in February through to April
- * Winter in the Sea of Cortez
- Main Activities:
- * 12 14 hrs whale watching over 2 days * Day trip to cave paintings
- * Visit to the old Spanish Misión San Francisco Javier de Viggé-Biaundó

WINIER (70°F)

(February/March)

Water and air temps. Are surprisingly cool!

- Lots of time spent hiking & wildlife viewing.
- * Snorkeling is cold and requires a wetsuit.
- * Peak season for migratory whales, as they settle into their winter grounds.
- * Peak season for juvenile whale sharks feeding in the area.

SPRING (80°F)

(April/May/June)

Perfect weather and respite from the high season crowds.

- * Equal time snorkeling, hiking & wildlife viewing.
- * Humpback whale season is ending, pregnant female whale sharks enter the area to feed, and blue whales can be observed.
- * Birders have the opportunity to observe several species of hatchlings.

SUMMER (90°F)

(July/August/Sept.)

Summer months are the hottest and can be extreme.

- * Sea turtles are well into their nesting season.
- * Lots of time spent snorkeling, kayaking and wildlife viewing.
- * Less time spent hiking.
- * Ideal season for world class snorkeling/diving.
- * Pilot, Orca and Finback whales can be found feeding in the area.

Summer Cruising Baja Style

FALL (80°F)

(Oct./ Nov./Dec.)

Fall marks a return to pleasant warm temps.

- * Peak season for world class snorkeling and diving.
- * Resident whales, such as Finbacks, can still be observed.
- * Sea turtle hatchlings appear after spending approx. 45 days incubating in their nests.
- * Juvenile whale sharks arrive to feed in the shallow zooplankton rich waters.
