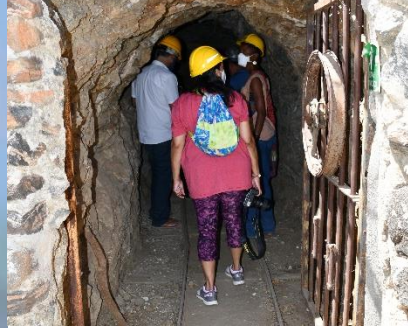
Itinerary

Day 1: The Adventure Begins

- The trip begins with our driver picking you up in Cabo and along the corridor to La Paz.
- Arrive to the Hotel Catedral in La Paz, check in at 3:00 pm, settle in and meet at 5:00 pm with cocktails in the atrium.
- Enjoy a special evening dinner courtesy of Panterra while getting to know fellow guests joining you on the trip.

Day 2: Puerto Chale – Magdalena Bay – Full Day

- 5:30 am morning departure to Puerto Chale (approx. 3-hour drive).
- Stop for an authentic Mexican Ranch breakfast enroute.
- Upon arrival in Puerto Chale we begin our 3 – 4 whale watching adventure to include exploring birdlife in a mangrove.
- After whale watching, enjoy a fresh seafood lunch from the bay.



Day 3: Exploring the Mining Town of El Triunfo – Full Day

- Breakfast, followed by a 9:00 am departure to the mining town of El Triunfo.
- Enjoy exploring an abandoned mining tunnel.
- Visit a mining museum chocked full of amazing history and stories.
- Enjoy lunch at the Minera Restaurant.
- After lunch visit the Vaquero (Baja cowboy) museum.

Day 4: Trip Concludes

- Breakfast
- Enjoy a morning in La Paz and hotel check-out is at 12:30 pm.
- The trip ends with our driver dropping you off in Cabo and along the corridor to La Paz.

Please Note: In the event of increment weather, activities scheduled may be reversed or an alternate activity will be offered.
