Join us on our 110-foot ship, the MV Adventure, for a true wilderness adventure with stunning Galapagos-style settings. This environment is perfect for wildlife and landscape photography, hiking, snorkelling, kayaking, and rare encounters. Embark on a journey of discovery to a world of a different time, place, and rhythm!











What to Expect (land and cruise excursions) - Our photographic expedition is meticulously designed with years of experience and research. We have considerable knowledge of locations, wildlife habits, stark landscapes, and timing for the best light. You'll achieve a perfect blend of anticipated shots, creative twists, and opportunities to enhance your photography skills by learning more about your camera.

The expedition is rated novice to moderate level, and travellers should be comfortable in a panga (skiff) on the water, hiking, walking, or standing for short periods. Hikes usually range from 1-2 hours on uneven terrain at low elevations in warm and humid conditions. Basic swimming skills and some snorkelling experiences are required. Travellers can opt out of any activity at any time, and we never engage in activities that compromise comfort or safety.

Panterra Experts in the Field – Join Lela Sankeralli, your lead naturalist and a local scientist from the Panterra team, for an informative evening presentation on local conservation efforts, environmental health, and the adaptations of animals to changing conditions. Your experts in the field will also provide cultural insights and share knowledge about the natural history of the flora, fauna, and geological sites you will visit. Don't miss out on this opportunity to learn and engage with experts in the field.

Hotel Accommodations - Hotel Catedral, La Paz (4-star rating) is a new concept of lodging that adapts to the needs of today's travellers. The hotel is situated in the historic center of the city, surrounded by several points of interest and located next to the oldest church in La Paz. With its sophisticated architecture in a contemporary modernist style, the hotel offers its guests a service of excellence and quality, both in the rooms and in its haute cuisine restaurant. It is more than a lodging. It is an invitation to an elegant, comfortable and relaxing stay.

Ground Transportation - As per your itinerary for the expedition, we have taken care of all your transportation needs. All the transporters we have arranged are certified and registered with both the Department of Transport and the Mexican Board of Tourism. If you decide to arrive early or extend your stay and explore independently, we would gladly suggest suitable transportation options if you need them.

Land Excursions – We have arranged for two half-day trips at the start and end of the expedition. The first trip will entail a cultural tour of La Paz, including a visit to a Modern Art Museum. The second trip will take you to explore El Triunfo, a quaint town rich in cultural history. Both trips are highly educational and culturally enriching.

The MV Adventure - SHIPS LAYOUT

Ships Crew - The Captain, engineer, and crew are onboard to ensure the safety and well-being of the group. They bring many years of mariner experience in the Sea of Cortez, reflecting the warmth, kindness, and hospitality of the people of Baja, Mexico. Ratio: 2 to 1, 16 guests to 8 crew/Panterra staff.

Ship Information - The "MV Adventure" is a 117' aluminum hull ship. As a certified passenger vessel, all crew, vessel paperwork, safety, and navigation equipment meet the legal requirements under the "Nacional de Seguridad Maritima" laws. The ship's inventory includes kayaks, snorkel gear, a ship's library, scientific equipment and two 28' pangas for ship-to-shore transport.

Ships Interior and Accommodations - Multiple-level decks are ideal for wildlife viewing, group gatherings and areas for relaxing. The upper deck offers a bird's eye view and a comfortable seating area. The main deck (bow) offers sea-level viewing, ideal for closer wildlife viewing and often hearing the animals communicate. The main deck (salon) offers dining and classroom space, a couch, and a TV for evening presentations. The main deck (stern) is ideal for snorkel gear and hanging wet close to dry. The below deck offers eight cabins with dbl occupancy (upper/lower bunks), vanity, sink, drawers, and cupboard space to unpack. Shower/bathroom facilities are separate from the staterooms. There are two sets of facilities; one for guys and one for gals.

Meals - Our meals consist of a variety of healthy and nutritious foods including fresh fruits, veggies, meat, and seafood. The cuisine reflects the Mexican culture and most dietary needs can be accommodated with advanced notice.

Daily Activities (during the cruise) – Normal activities include wildlife viewing, hiking, kayaking and snorkeling. In addition, we have scheduled a 60 – 90 min. "classroom" session at the beginning of the trip. The goal will be to go over basic techniques, Santisouk's approach to photography and the list of recommended equipment she will be sending you. While at sea, and right after lunch, we will have a short session from the morning shoot and go over additional techniques and the plans for an evening shoot.

The daily schedule at sea will be:

- Wake up at sunrise, have a quick tea/coffee and pre-breakfast of fruit, yogurts and cereals.
- Shoot from sunrise to maybe around 11:00 am
- Brunch at 11:00 am
- Short collaboration session 1:00 pm 1:30 pm

- Rest, nap, personal time 1:30 pm 3:30 pm
- Snack 3:30 pm 4:00 pm
- Shoot till sunset 4:00 pm 7:00 pm
- Dinner at 8:00 pm

At this time of the year, the Sea of Cortez is where great whales such as blues, humpbacks, and orcas spend their winter. This expedition offers unforgettable experiences with rare wildlife sightings and breathtaking landscapes.

PRINT ITINERARY

Itinerary

The Baja California Peninsula is beautifully embraced by two bodies of water: the Pacific Ocean and the Sea of Cortez. A striking natural beauty set in a dramatic backdrop of rugged mountains and desert islands with high cliffs dropping down to sandy beaches and crystal-clear turquoise waters. It is rich in natural history, unspoiled in beauty, and unrivalled in rare marine and terrestrial wildlife.

Day 1 (Apr. 19) - Arriving in La Paz

Upon your arrival at the Cabo (SJD) or La Paz International Airport (LAP), our drivers will transfer you to the Hotel Catedral in La Paz for your first night's stay.

*Drive Time: Cabo to La Paz - 2.5 hours / La Paz to Hotel - 20 mins. D

Day 2 - 6 - Land Excursion and Boarding the Ship, the MV Adventure

On Day 2, we will check out of the hotel at 12 pm and depart on a half-day land

excursion touring the City of La Paz. Our drivers will then transfer the group to the marina at 5:00 pm, where the ship will be docked. Once onboard, guests will be shown to their cabins as we ready the ship for immediate departure to the islands. Please see daily ship activities as outlined on page 3. On Day 6, disembark the ship at 10:00 am. *Cruising Time:* 4 - 6 hours sailing per day

Day 6 (Apr. 24) – Disembarkation and By Land Half-Day Trip

On Day 6, at disembarkation, our drivers will pick guests up and depart on a half-day land excursion to explore a town rich in cultural history. Visit a Mining Museum, enjoy lunch and shopping, then complete the day trip with a visit to the Vaquero (Baja cowboys and ranching) Museum. Our drivers will then transfer the group to the Hotel Catedral for their 3/4:00 pm check-in.

Excursion Time: 5/6 hours

Day 7 (Apr. 25) – A Free Day to Explore La Paz

Enjoy a free day poolside and/or explore the famous Malecon seawalk. Stroll along the seaside and take in all the shops and restaurants. You may also want to visit one of the local museums. Enjoy a last evening group dinner on the shores of the Bay of La Paz.

Day 8 (Apr. 26) - Hotel Check Out

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast, check out of the hotel and our driver will return guests to the La Paz or Cabo International Airport for your flight home.

Drive Time: La Paz to Cabo 2.5 hours
